Crisp, clean and tangy. Meyer lemon meets breakfast pink grapefruit and grapefruit rind. Sweet on the nose, yet tart and dry on the palate. Perfect wine for outdoors to finish the summer off and coast into fall. Drink before year's end.

Goldschmidt "Singing Tree" Chardonnay, Russian River Valley, CA 2014

Hands down the best Russian River Valley chardonnay under \$40 I have ever had. Russian River Valley is nestled in the heart of Sonoma and is arguably considered the best region in America to grow and make chardonnay, so usually they are quite pricey. What a find this Goldschmidt is. Incredibly balanced, lemon, apple, vanilla with a perfect agreeable layer of French oak.
